DO NOT APPLY EXCESSIVE FORCE TO THE POLES DURING ASSEMBLY.**

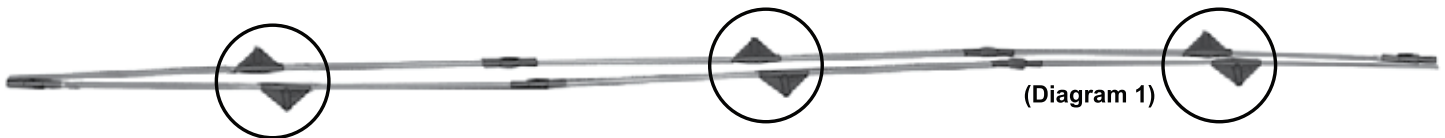
Enjoy your Play Structure and be sure to contact us for any further information or help.

Step 1. Connect and lay out all of the individual poles to ensure that you have all of the following:

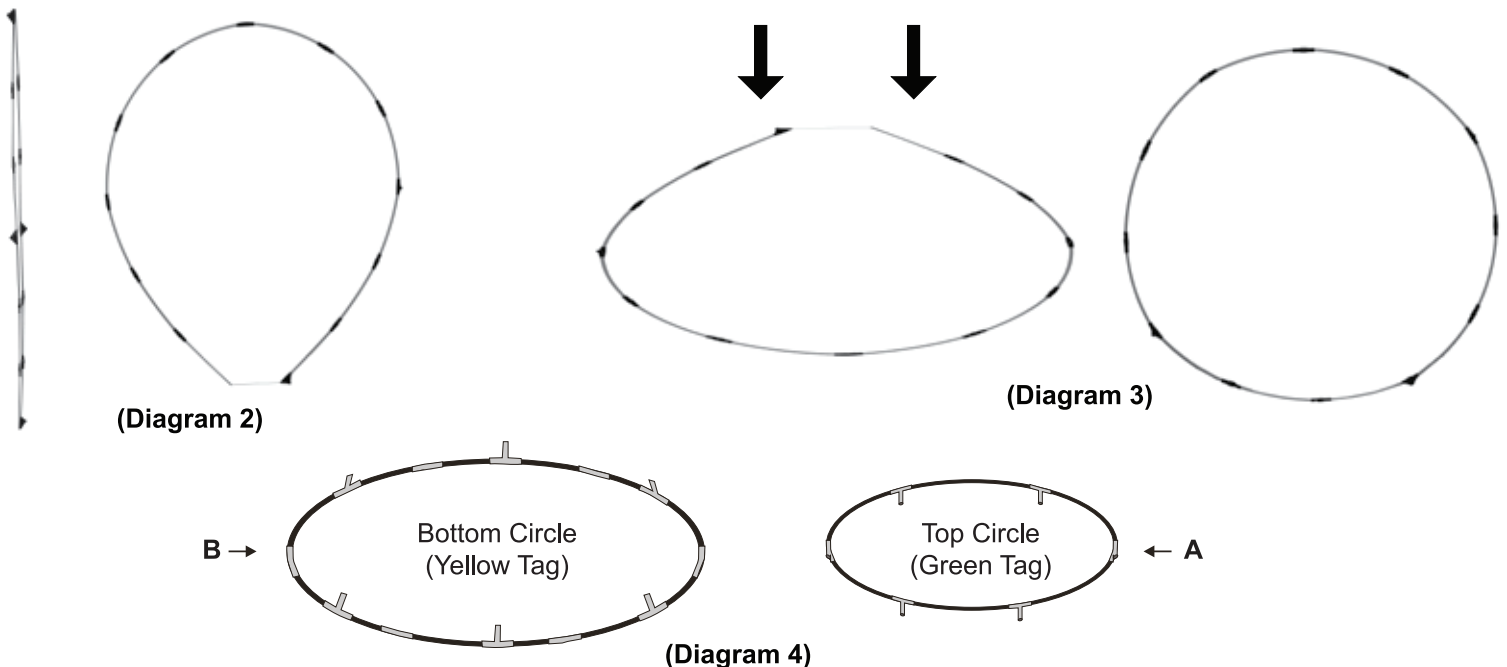
- A** = 6 Section pole with cord connecting all pieces with Green tags (qty 1 ~ 79.5" length)
- B** = 12 Section pole with cord connecting all pieces with Yellow tags (qty 1 ~ 150" length)
- C** = 3 Section poles with cord connecting all pieces with Blue tags (qty 6 ~ 41" length)

Step 2. Assembling the Circles

First you will need to make a circle from the **(B)** Yellow tagged 12 section pole. Connect the sections together until you have two straight sections that are six (6) sections a piece **(Diagram 1)**.



Hold the pole vertically. Grasp the top sections of the pole and while pushing downward connect the top triangular connector to the yellow pole section. This will result in a "U" shape forming **(Diagram 2)**. Now take the opposite end and bring it up to connect it together. Push downward on both sides you are going to connect, using the floor as resistance with the opposite side. Once connected you should have a circle shape **(Diagram 3)**. Repeat this process with the 6 Section **(A)** Green Tagged Pole to complete the top and bottom Circles **(Diagram 4)**.

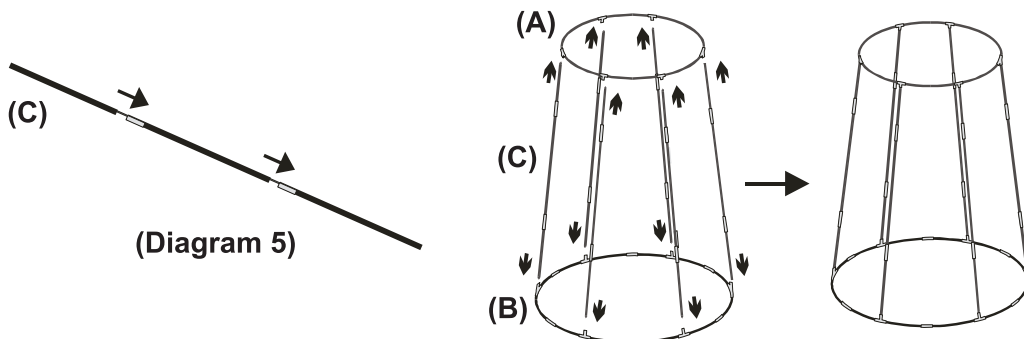

Step 3. Finishing Frame Assembly

Once all circles are completed, move onto constructing the (C) Blue Tagged frame poles (Diagram 5). Insert all poles into connectors until you have 6 straight poles measuring approximately 41" long. Once you have this completed, use the (C) Blue Tagged Poles to connect the 2 circles with the (B) Yellow Tagged larger circle as the base and the (A) Green Tagged smaller circle as the top. Thus creating a conical shape minus the tip (Diagram 6).



Insert the (C) Blue tagged poles into the top and bottom circle connectors. (Diagram 6)

Step 4. Adding Tent Body to the Frame

Put outer covering onto the frame, starting at the top, gently pull and adjust the covering until you have it completely covering the frame. Slide the (B) bottom circle of the frame into the pole sleeve on the bottom of the tent body. Attach the floor sheet below the tent body by the Velcro sewn on the sheet.



Step 5. Attachments

Now you can attach monkey faces onto the tent body by attaching the Velcro sewn onto the tent body and the detachable themselves. The palm fronds have insertable poles that fit into the sleeves sewn onto the fronds. Once inserted into the sleeves you can attach them to the top of the play tent by sliding the end tips into sleeves sewn into the top of the play tent. Finish securing the palms to the tent using the Velcro sewn onto the tent body and the palm fronds themselves. The Tent is now ready for Monkeying around!
